What is a coalition?

Why have a coalition?



- Concentrates the focus on a particular problem
- Creates alliances among those who might not normally work together
- Keeps the community's approach to issues consistent
- Creates effective and efficient delivery of programs and eliminates any unnecessary duplication of effort
