2 Act of Washington without admitting or denying the Securities Division's allegations and conclusions. State  
3 Ignition Interlock Services, LLC and Thomas Parmenter acknowledge the Securities Division's jurisdiction over  
4 this matter and its authority to enter this order.

5 Based upon the foregoing:

6 IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND ORDERED that State Ignition Interlock Services, LLC and Thomas  
7 Parmenter, and their agents and employees, each shall cease and desist from the offer and sale of unregistered  
8 franchises in the State of Washington in violation of RCW 19.100.020.

9 IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND ORDERED that State Ignition Interlock Services, LLC and Thomas  
10 Parmenter inform any of the persons or companies granted a license or sublicense to distribute, sell, lease or rent  
11 Autosense ignition interlock systems in the state of Washington of the existence and contents of this Order within  
12 30 days of the entry of the Order.

13 IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND ORDERED that State Ignition Interlock Services, LLC and Thomas  
14 Parmenter each shall disclose the existence of this Order in its offering circulars to be used in the state of  
15 Washington for a period of 5 years from the date of entry of this order.

16 IT IS THEREFORE AGREED that State Ignition Interlock Services, LLC and Thomas Parmenter shall  
17 reimburse the Securities Division \$1500 for its costs incurred in its investigation of this matter.

18 IT IS THEREFORE AGREED that State Ignition Interlock Services, LLC and Thomas Parmenter, waive the  
19 right to a hearing in this matter.
