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**INTRODUCTION**

On February 2, 2010, the Securities Administrator of the State of the Washington entered a Statement of Charges and Notice of Intent to Enter Order to Cease and Desist, S-09-450-09-SC01, against Respondents AIG Promotions, LLC, and Davidan Corporation, d/b/a Bankcard Empire.

Pursuant to the Business Opportunity Fraud Act of Washington, RCW 19.110, the Securities Division of the Department of Financial Institutions and AIG Promotions, LLC do hereby enter into this CONSENT ORDER in settlement of the above-captioned matter. The Securities Division made certain allegations and conclusions in the Statement of Charges, set forth under the headings "Tentative Findings of Fact" and "Conclusions of Law." Respondent neither admits nor denies the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as set forth in the Statement of Charges, which are hereby incorporated by reference into this Consent Order.

1 IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent, AIG Promotions, LLC, their agents and  
2 employees, each shall cease and desist from offering or selling business opportunities in violation of RCW  
3 19.110.050, the registration section of the Business Opportunity Fraud Act of the State of Washington.

4 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent, AIG Promotions, LLC, their  
5 agents and employees, each shall cease and desist from violating RCW 19.110.070, the disclosure  
6 document section of the Business Opportunity Fraud Act of the State of Washington.

7 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent, AIG Promotions, LLC, their  
8 agents and employees, each shall cease and desist from violating RCW 19.110.120, the anti-fraud section  
9 of the Business Opportunity Fraud Act of the State of Washington.

10 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondent, AIG Promotions, LLC, shall pay  
11 the Securities Division the costs and other expenses incurred in the investigation of this matter in the  
12 amount of \$900 on or before the date of entry of this Consent Order.

14 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Securities Division has jurisdiction to enter this Order.

15 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that in consideration of the foregoing, Respondent, AIG Promotions,  
16 LLC, waives its rights to a hearing in this matter and judicial review of this order.

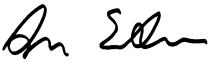
