INTRODUCTION

On March 7, 2016 the Securities Administrator of the Securities Division of the Department of Financial Institutions (“Securities Division”) issued a Statement of Charges and Notice of Intent to Enter Order to Cease and Desist, to Impose Fines, and to Charge Costs (“Statement of Charges”) Order Number S-14-1603-16-SC01, against Respondents Life Partners, Inc.; Life Partners Holdings, Inc.; Brian Pardo; R. Scott Peden; David Barr; James Billington; Kim Butler; Gary Cassill; Michael Chapman; Tomas Delos Santos; Neal Inscoe; John Ley; William Meyer; Steven Minnich; Tim Watters; Don Wells; Alliance of Professionals for Business, Inc.; NW Retirement Solutions LLC; NW Safe Retirement LLC; Partners Portfolio Solutions, Inc.; and Strategic Insurance Services, LLC.

Pursuant to the Securities Act of Washington, RCW 21.20, the Securities Division and Respondents Neal Inscoe and Alliance of Professionals for Business, Inc. do hereby enter into this Consent Order in settlement of the matters set forth in the Statement of Charges. Respondents Neal Inscoe and Alliance of Professionals for Business, Inc. neither admit nor deny the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as set forth in the Statement of Charges, which are hereby incorporated by reference into this Consent Order.

CONSENT ORDER

Based upon the foregoing and finding it in the public interest:

IT IS AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents Neal Inscoe and Alliance of Professionals for Business, Inc., and their agents and employees, each shall cease and desist from violating RCW 21.20.140, the securities registration section of the Securities Act of Washington.

1 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents Neal Inscoe and Alliance of Professionals for
2 Business, Inc., and their agents and employees, each shall cease and desist from violating RCW 21.20.040, the
3 securities salesperson registration section of the Securities Act of Washington.

4 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents Neal Inscoe and Alliance of Professionals for
5 Business, Inc. shall cease and desist from violating RCW 21.20.010, the anti-fraud section of the Securities Act of
6 Washington.

7 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents Neal Inscoe and Alliance of Professionals for
8 Business, Inc. shall pay a fine of \$1,750 prior to the entry of this Consent Order.

9 IT IS FURTHER AGREED AND ORDERED that Respondents Neal Inscoe and Alliance of Professionals for
10 Business, Inc. shall pay costs of \$250 prior to the entry of this Consent Order.

11 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that the Securities Division has jurisdiction to enter this Consent Order.

12 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that Respondents Neal Inscoe and Alliance of Professionals for Business, Inc.
13 enter into this Consent Order freely and voluntarily and with a full understanding of its terms and significance.

14 IT IS FURTHER AGREED that in consideration of the foregoing, Respondents Neal Inscoe and Alliance of
15 Professionals for Business, Inc. waive their rights to a hearing and to judicial review of this matter pursuant to RCW
16 21.20.440 and Chapter 34.05 RCW.

17 WILLFUL VIOLATION OF THIS ORDER IS A CRIMINAL OFFENSE.


