and further agrees that the issues raised in the above-capt	ioned matter may be economically and efficiently settled
by entry of this Consent Order. The parties intend this C	onsent Order to fully resolve the Statement of Charges

A. Jurisdiction. It is AGREED that the Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter of the activities discussed herein.

B. Waiver of Hearing. It is AGREED that Respondent has been informed of the right to a hearing
before an administrative law judge, and that he hereby waives his right to a hearing and any and all administrative
and judicial review of the issues raised in this matter, or of the resolution reached herein. Accordingly,
Respondent, by his signature below, withdraws his appeal to the Office of Administrative Hearings.

- C. License Surrender. It is AGREED that Respondent shall surrender his Mortgage Broker license and
  file a Mortgage Broker Closure Report upon entry of this Consent Order.
- 9 D. Mortgage Broker Annual Report. It is AGREED that Respondent shall file a Mortgage Broker
  10 Annual Report for the year 2008 upon entry of this Consent Order.
- E. Declaration of Activity. It is AGREED that Respondent shall sign a Declaration of Activity
   covering the dates of September 9, 2009, through December 31, 2009, upon entry of this Consent Order.
- F. Fine. It is AGREED that Respondent shall pay to the Department a fine of \$1,400, in the form of a
  cashier's check made payable to the "Washington State Treasurer," upon entry of this Consent Order.

15 G. Agreement Not to Apply. It is AGREED that Respondent shall not apply for a license issued by the Department under the Mortgage Broker Practices Act (Chapter 19.146 RCW), Consumer Loan Act (Chapter 31.04 16 RCW), Check Cashers and Sellers Act (Chapter 31.45 RCW), Escrow Agent Registration Act (Chapter 18.44 17 RCW), or Uniform Money Services Act (Chapter 19.230 RCW) for a period of five (5) years from the date of 18 entry of this Consent Order. This paragraph does not limit Respondent's ability to apply for a license as a Loan 19 Originator or Mortgage Loan Originator under either the Mortgage Broker Practices Act (Chapter 19.146 RCW) 20 or the Consumer Loan Act (Chapter 31.04 RCW). It is further AGREED that the Department shall not use the 21 facts from this case to determine whether a loan originator license shall be issued. Respondent understands and 22 AGREES that nothing in this Consent Order shall alter or affect the statutory requirements to obtain a loan 23

originator license, and that this Consent Order specifically does not guarantee that a loan originator license shall 1 2 be issued.

## H. Investigation Fee. It is AGREED that Respondent shall pay to the Department an investigation fee of \$206.40, in the form of a cashier's check made payable to the "Washington State Treasurer," upon entry of this Consent Order.

I. Non-Compliance with Order. It is AGREED that Respondent understands that failure to abide 6 7 by the terms and conditions of this Consent Order may result in further legal action by the Director. In the event of such legal action, Respondent may be responsible to reimburse the Director for the cost incurred in 8 pursuing such action, including but not limited to, attorney fees. 9

J. Voluntarily Entered. It is AGREED that the undersigned Respondent has voluntarily entered into 10 this Consent Order, which is effective when signed by the Director's designee. 11

K. Completely Read, Understood, and Agreed. It is AGREED that Respondent has read this Consent Order in its entirety and fully understands and agrees to all of the same.

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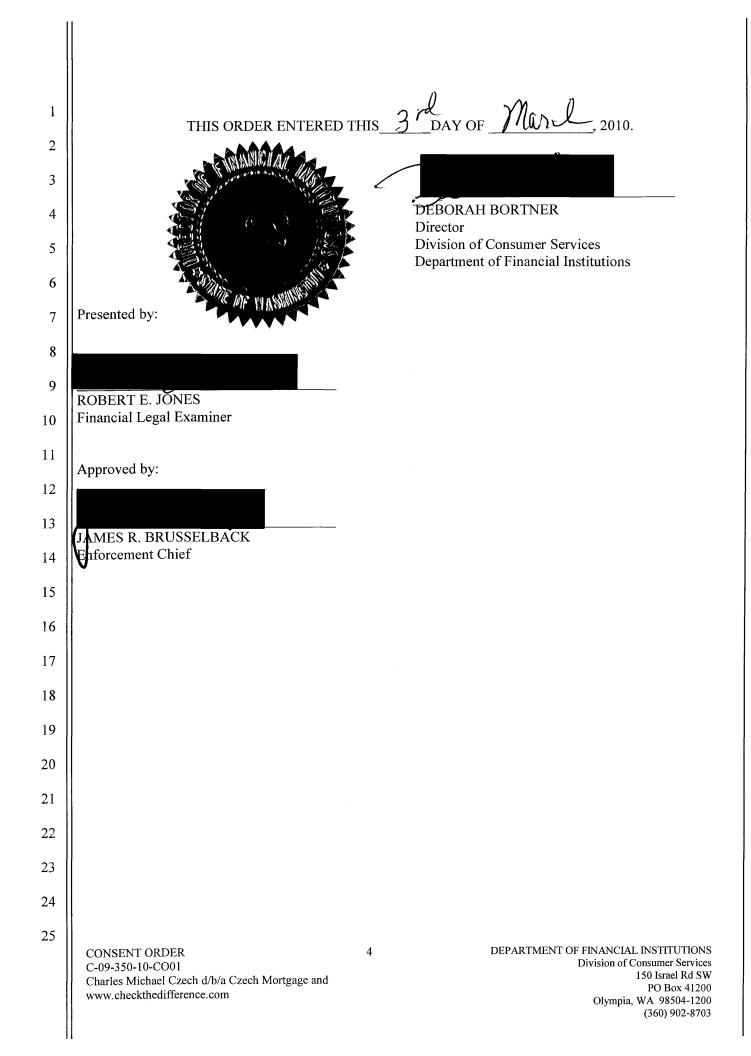

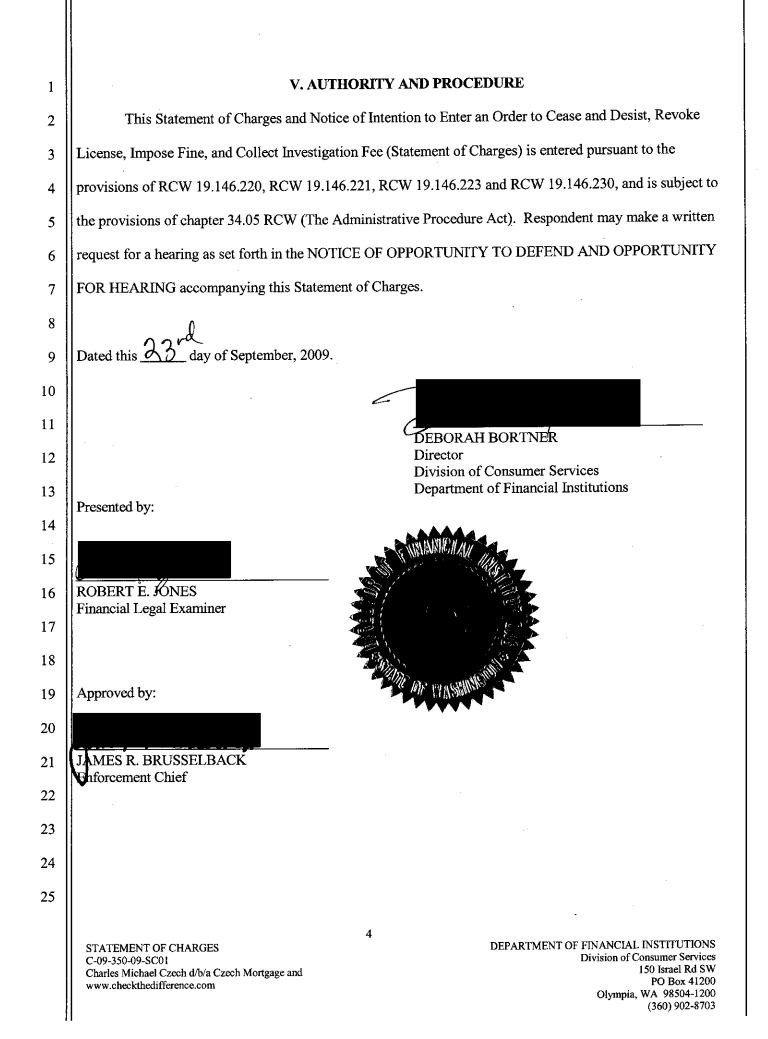

12	Mortgage Broker Practices Act (Act) <sup>1</sup> . After having conducted an investigation pursuant to RCW 19.146.235, and			
13 14	based upon the facts available as of the date of this Statement of Charges, the Director, through his designee,			
14	Division of Consumer Services Director Deborah Bortner, institutes this proceeding and finds as follows:			
16	I. FACTUAL AL	LEGATIONS

18	was licensed by the Department of Financial Institutions of the State of Washington (Department) to conduct			
19	business as a mortgage broker on May 16, 2007, and continues to be licensed to date. Respondent Czech was			
20	named Designated Broker on May 16, 2007, and has continued as Designated Broker to date. Respondent			
21	Czech is licensed to conduct the business of a mortgage broker at the following location:

23 24	<b>1.2</b> Failure to File Annual Report. Respondent did not file his 2008 Mortgage Broker Annual Report by			
24	the due date of March 31, 2009.

Failure to Maintain Bond. On August 4, 2009, the Department received notice from the Hartford Fire 1.3 1 Insurance Company that Respondent Czech's surety bond would be cancelled, effective September 9, 2009. On 2 September 9, 2009, Respondent Czech's surety bond was cancelled. To date, Respondent has failed to provide 3 the required surety bond. 4 On-Going Investigation. The Department's investigation into the alleged violations of the Act by 5 1.4 Respondents continues to date. 6 **II. GROUNDS FOR ENTRY OF ORDER** 7 Definition of Mortgage Broker. Pursuant to RCW 19.146.010(12) and WAC 208-660-006, 2.1 8 "Mortgage Broker" means any person who for compensation or gain, or in the expectation of compensation or 9 gain (a) assists a person in obtaining or applying to obtain a residential mortgage loan or (b) holds himself or 10 herself out as being able to assist a person in obtaining or applying to obtain a residential mortgage loan. 11 Requirement to File Annual Report. Based on the Factual Allegations set forth in Section I above, 2.2 12 Respondent is in apparent violation of RCW 19.146.290 and WAC 208-660-400(1) and (2) for failing to timely 13 file an annual report of mortgage broker activity. 14 Requirement to Maintain Surety Bond. Based on the Factual Allegations set forth in Section I 2.3 15 above, Respondent is in apparent violation of RCW 19.146.205(4)(a) and WAC 208-660-175(1) for failing to 16 file and maintain a surety bond with the Department. 17 **III. AUTHORITY TO IMPOSE SANCTIONS** 18 Authority to Issue an Order to Cease and Desist. Pursuant to RCW 19.146.220(4), the Director may 3.1 19 issue orders directing a licensee, its employee, loan originator, independent contractor, agent, or other person 20 subject to this chapter to cease and desist from conducting business. 21 Authority to Revoke License. Pursuant to RCW 19.146.220(2)(c) and (e) the Director may revoke a 22 3.2 license for failure to pay a fee required by the Director or maintain the required bond, or any violation of the 23 Act. 24 25

1	<b>3.3</b> Authority to Impose Fine. Pursuant to RCW 19.146.220(2) and (3)(a) and WAC 208-660-530(6), the		
2	Director may impose fines on a licensee, employee, loan originator, independent contractor, or agent of the		
3	licensee, or other person subject to the Act for any violation of RCW 19.146.205(4) or any violation of the Act.		
4	<b>3.4</b> Authority to Collect Investigation Fee. Pursuant to RCW 19.146.228(2), WAC 208-660-520(9) and		
5	WAC 208-660-550(4) upon completion of any investigation of the books and records of a licensee or other person		
6	subject to the Act, the Department will furnish to the licensee or other person subject to the Act a billing to cover		
7	the cost of the investigation. The investigation charge will be calculated at the rate of forty-eight dollars (\$48) per		
8	hour that each staff person devoted to the investigation.		
9	IV. NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ENTER ORDER		
10	Respondent's violations of the provisions of chapter 19.146 RCW and chapter 208-660 WAC, as set forth		
11	in the above Factual Allegations, Grounds for Entry of Order, and Authority to Impose Sanctions, constitute a basis		
12	for the entry of an Order under RCW 19.146.220, RCW 19.146.221 and RCW 19.146.223. Therefore, it is the		
13	Director's intention to ORDER that:		
14	4.1 Respondent Charles Michael Czech d/b/a Czech Mortgage and www.checkthedifference.com cease and desist from conducting the business of a mortgage broker;

16	<b>4.2</b> Respondent Charles Michael Czech d/b/a Czech Mortgage and www.checkthedifference.com's license to conduct the business of a mortgage broker be revoked;		
17	<b>4.3</b> Respondent Charles Michael Czech d/b/a Czech Mortgage and www.checkthedifference.com pay a fine which as of the date of this Statement of Charges totals \$2,900; and

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**II. GROUNDS FOR ENTRY OF ORDER** 1 Requirement to Maintain Surety Bond. Based on the Factual Allegations set forth in Section I 2 2.1 above, Respondent is in apparent violation of RCW 19.146.205(4)(a) and WAC 208-660-175(1) for failing to 3 4 file and maintain a surety bond with the Department. **III. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE TEMPORARY ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST** 5 Authority to Issue Temporary Order to Cease and Desist. Pursuant to RCW 19.146.227, the 3.1 6 Director is authorized to issue a temporary order to cease and desist whenever the Director determines that the 7 public is likely to be substantially injured by delay in issuing a cease and desist order. Based on the Factual 8 Findings and Grounds for Entry of Order set forth above, Respondent Czech does not maintain the required 9 surety bond, and the public is likely to be substantially injured by the lack of said surety bond coverage. 10 **IV. ORDER** 11 Based on the above Factual Findings, Grounds for Entry of Order, and Authority to Issue Temporary 12 Order to Cease and Desist, and pursuant to RCW 19.146.227, the Director determines that the public is likely to 13 be substantially harmed by a delay in entering a cease and desist order. Therefore, the Director ORDERS that: 14 Respondent shall immediately cease and desist from participating in the conduct of the affairs of any 4.1 15 mortgage broker subject to licensure by the Director, in any manner, specifically including, but not limited to 16 originating any residential mortgage loan, assisting with the origination of any residential mortgage loan, and 17 holding out as able to assist any person with applying for or obtaining any residential mortgage loan. 18 This order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless set aside, limited, or 4.2 19 suspended in writing by an authorized court. 20 NOTICE 21 PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 19.146 RCW, YOU ARE ENTITLED TO A HEARING WITHIN 14 DAYS 22 OF REQUEST TO DETERMINE WHETHER THIS ORDER SHALL BECOME PERMANENT.
