8 Institutions, identified as Final Order No. C-07-043-07-FO01; and


9 2. That the Petitioner, State of Washington, Department of Financial Institutions,  
10 is awarded judgment against Respondent Mitchell L. Sweeten in the amount of \$62,579.02,  
11 representing statutory attorney's fees of \$200, a filing fee of \$200, a service of process charge  
12 of \$71.20, and \$62,107.82 for the civil monetary sanctions imposed in the Department of  
13 Financial Institution's Final Order No. C-07-043-07-FO01, as set forth in the Department's  
14 Petition for Enforcement of Order.
